

A Survey For The New Chatham County Community Library

Summary of the Results

Respondents were asked which three items were most important to them. These item numbers were weighted. The first item was given 3 points, the second 2 points, and the third item 1 point.

Below is the ranking in order of perceived importance:

1. A sustainable design (445 points,)
2. A colorful children's room (369 points)
3. A space for teens (224 points)
4. Comfortable reading spaces (191 points)
5. Café and used bookstore (148 points--many responders wanted only the bookstore)
6. Study room for CCCC student (141 points)
7. Modern technology (139 points)
8. Local history and Genealogy (112 points)
9. Art (111 points)
10. Large meeting room (108 points)
11. Small meeting rooms (67 points)

Many responders included suggestions and remarks. These comments will be reviewed carefully by the New Library Consultant and Project Architect. These comments are on file with the Friends of the Pittsboro Library and at the County Manager's office.
